The Bosnia and Herzegovina (hereinafter called "Borrower") has received financing from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD) and European Investment Bank (EIB) (the "Banks") in the form of a credit (hereinafter called credit toward the cost of Federation Road Sector Modernization Project. The JP Ceste Federacije BiH, an implementing agency of the Client, intends to apply a portion of the proceeds of this credit to eligible payments under the contract for which this Request for Proposals is issued. Payments by the Bank will be made only at the request of the Client and upon approval by the Bank, and will be subject, in all respects, to the terms and conditions of the loan agreement. The loan agreement prohibits a withdrawal from the credit account for the purpose of any payment to persons or entities, or for any import of goods, if such payment or import, to the knowledge of the Bank, is prohibited by a decision of the United Nations Security Council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations. No party other than the Client shall derive any rights from the loan agreement or have any claims to the proceeds of the credit.

The JP Ceste Federacije BiH d.o.o., Sarajevo now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for: External Quality Control for Construction of Road Stari Neum - Drenovac. More details on the Services are provided in the Description of the Services (Section IX).

Anticipated completion date of services will be: November 2020.

Bidding will be conducted through the Non-Consulting Services Bidding procedures as specified in the World Bank's Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers January 2011, revised July 2014 ("Procurement Guidelines"), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Guidelines. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 1.6 and 1.7 setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.
